2015 is a thrilling vintage of rich yet vibrant wines. Winter was very snowy and mild temperatures since the month of February lead to an early bud break. By flowering, which took place in the middle of May, the season was about 10 days ahead of norm. More rain fell between end of May and early June and this was a great help for the vines to overcome a very hot month of July. 2015 was a kind vintage with very healthy fruit and the loss of production is mainly due to sporadic, yet very brutal hailstorms (starting May 8th) as well as attributed to the summer heat. Harvest was slightly anticipated and fruit quality great across the board, from the white varietals to Dolcetto, Barbera and Nebbiolo.
